You can pre-register, be allocated your exhibitor number and collect exhibitor cards on Friday 11th September 2026 from Woodcote village hall between 3 pm and 5 pm.

Fill in the entry form which you will find on the back page. Please note 'one' entry form per person. If more forms are required, please copy the form.

Entry Fees Adults - 50p per entry (capped at £5)
 Children (15 and under) - FREE entry for children's classes
 50p per entry if entering adult classes (capped at £5)

Rules

- You may only show **ONE** exhibit in each category.
- The hall will be closed for Judging and will only reopen once finished.
- All exhibits **MUST NOT** be removed before 4 pm. All exhibits are to be removed from the hall by 5 pm; if they are not removed, they will be sold or disposed of.
- A table top exhibit sale will commence at 5 pm for non-collected exhibits or those offered for sale as noted on the exhibitors card.
- Please label clearly any baking entries that may contain nuts.
- The sunflower competition is open to all age groups. A photo including a person for scale and measurement from earth to top of flower head must be included.
- Any exhibits entered in this fete must not have been entered in any other show.
- **All exhibits are left at the owner's risk.**
- The judge's decision must be accepted as final.
